





WEATHER IN SERFAUS-FISS-LADIS

Your holiday is approaching swiftly and the anticipation is growing. The first question that comes to mind: How is the weather going to be in the Alps of Serfaus-Fiss-Ladis? All current weather data and daily trends, including forecast for the upcoming days, are available at a glance now!


today, Tuesday 18.04.2023


The weather patterns will be very varied throughout the upcoming days, April weather is expected. Cloudy conditions will be followed by sunshine, sunshine will be followed by showers. The temperatures will heavily leap. From Wednesday through Thursday, an upper low will interfere with the weather patterns, which will increase the uncertainty of the weather patterns. Wednesday will start sunny and friendly, the clouds will soon become denser from the east and a first, slight risk for showers will revive from the late afternoon onwards. This heavily cloudy and unsteady weather cycle will remain unchanged until Friday morning. The snow line will range between 1100m and 1600m above sea level. A weather improvement is expected throughout Friday and the temperatures will begin to increase. Saturday promises to become the warmest day of the week. Denser clouds are expected again on Sunday. A foehny south-westerly wind will provide for mostly dry conditions. Spring-like mild temperatures will prevail.




