ADVENTURE MOUNTAINS. SERFAUS. FISS. LADIS.

Enjoy exciting nature experiences!

Thomas Brezina's Adventure Mountains. Our three adventure hiking trails for families will captivate and fascinate your children, as they are designed to let them discover the great outdoors (and much more) through play and must solve all sorts of puzzles, just like detectives. The colourful adventure pad is available for €2 from all Serfaus-Fiss-Ladis cable car ticket offices and the Serfaus-Fiss-Ladis tourist information offices. All of the income generated by "Country Charity – We are Family" benefits local and regional social projects. The patron of the project is the author and TV presenter Thomas Brezina.

Piratenweg. Serfaus. On a stormy night, a ghost ship has been sighted. On board: Captain Pepper and the sailor Chilli. To make matters worse, the ship and all aboard have been cursed! Everything is now up to the master detectives. They must find the treasure. However, where on earth is the treasure chest hidden, and what is the treasure that must be found? Pram-friendly. Walking time approx. 2 hours.

Hexenweg. Fiss. The young witch Peppina and her brother Fips urgently need help! There has been an explosion on the Hexenweg Trail. The two young magicians have blown up the witch's house. Numerous objects have been whirled through the air and scattered along the trail. Not suitable for prams (a pram-friendly path with the same start and end points runs alongside parts of the trail). Walking time approx. 1.5 - 3 hours.

Forscherpfad. Ladis. Oops! The hikers suddenly feel as if they've been shrunk and see everything from an ant-sized perspective! What on earth has happened? All we know is that a mysterious tree house has been discovered in the middle of the forest. Not suitable for prams. Walking time approx. 1 hour.

HÖG ADVENTURE PARK. SERFAUS.

The Hög Adventure Park is all about Alpine farming and forestry. A fairy tale about how the Högsee lake came into being is told in a giant milk churn. There are numerous exciting play areas dotted around the Högsee lake. A shallow water area was created especially for the youngest visitors. Water sports enthusiasts can explore the lake on pedalos or rafts, or dare to jump into the water from the diving tower. Several bathing jetties and a floating island invite visitors to relax and sunbathe. In the full-service restaurant Seealm Hög, we will spoil you with trendy vegetarian and vegan dishes, fish specialities, home-made ice cream, smoked trout and home-made bread, for example.

Apiary. Welcome to the Hög Adventure Park bee kingdom, where you can watch the busy insects close up and learn lots about them, look inside a beehive and learn all about beekeeping.

Hög Family Lights Chapel. This peaceful place for quiet contemplation is situated at the end of the Högsee lake. It is suitable for the whole family and welcomes all faiths. It is also the starting point of the 450-metre Contemplation Trail, which features seven artistic sculptures that symbolise the Lord's Prayer.

SCHNEISENFEGER FAMILY COASTER SERFAUS.

The Schneisenfeger is a winter and summer toboggan run that offers the perfect sledging fun. It runs from the Alpkopf to Högsee lake – the entrance is located in an old sawmill, right next to the Seealm Hög restaurant at an altitude of 1,820 metres. From there, you are pulled up to the Alpkopf, already seated on the Schneisenfeger. From the top, tobogganing fans can hurtle down a specially designed 1.5km run at speeds of up to 40km/h that ends at the Hög Adventure Park. Enjoy the glorious 360-degree views from the viewing tower at the end of the run, accompanied by plenty of detailed information.

SUMMER FUN PARK. FISS.

The Summer Fun Park Fiss will keep the whole family entertained. The three main attractions offer plenty of fun and pure adrenaline: the "Fisser Flitzer", the "Fisser Flieger" and the "Skyswing". There is also a huge jump tower where you can jump onto inflatable airbags and can do somersaults and all sorts of tricks. This attraction is thirteen metres high. You can jump from two platforms at different heights (seven and ten metres); plenty of action quaranteed!

Your children can splash around in the cool water play area or swing, slide, bounce or balance in the various playgrounds. Go for a leisurely walk along the Fisser Gonde Nature Trail or through our petting zoo. Walking the circular barefoot trail, which includes a Kneipp therapy pool, is beneficial to your health.

Enjoy the sunshine on the Möseralm's large terrace whilst your kids let off steam in the XXL sandpit or on the bouncy castle, or ride over the various obstacles and around the steep curves that encircle the sandpits on a LIKEaBIKE.

Younger children are also bound to enjoy driving the electric cars around the Solarbar or having fun on our tube run. Teenagers, on the other hand, will love the trampoline and the slackline park.

At the Möseralm mountain restaurant, we spoil you with no-nonsense, hearty dishes and a choice of fresh salads. For those with a sweet tooth, we also offer a wide selection of home-made cakes, tempting desserts and refreshing ice cream sundaes.

FISSER FLITZER. FISS.

An experience you won't forget in a hurry: On this 2.2km summer toboggan run, you'll hurtle down towards the valley through bends and also along straight sections where you'll really pick up speed, reaching up to 45km/h. The run has plenty of surprises in store for you, such as the Jungle Cave, the Dinosaur Tunnel, the Ice Cave, the Creepy Tunnel, the Burning Barn and the Pirate Ship, and also features a section where your speed will be measured. By the way: At all times, you decide when to brake and when to accelerate!

SKYSWING. FISSER FLIEGER. FISS.

Skyswing. A ride with addiction potential: For that one fantastic moment when the centrifugal force and gravity are suspended, your body feels completely weightless. The new Skyswing holds up to eight people at the same time and offers a choice of three different swing speeds (15%, 40% or 100%).

Fisser Flieger. Even just the preparations make you feel like a pro: You put on a pilot's vest, buckle up, give the operator the thumbs up and take off! Safely strapped into a kite-like contraption, you'll zoom across the Möseralm at 80 km/h at a height of up to 47 metres. The passengers hang in a hang glider harness that makes them feel as if they were in free flight yet nevertheless ensures optimum safety.

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SERFAUSER SAUSER. SERFAUS.

Soaring over the heads of the hikers below at a height of 85 metres and speeds of up to 65km/h is certainly a very special experience! The Serfauser Sauser is an enjoyable ride that is as unusual as it is intoxicating. Securely strapped in and under the supervision of trained guides, you will whizz down to the Komperdell cable car bottom station from the Sunliner top station in four stages.

MURMLIWASSER. SERFAUS.

Water, sand and many interactive play stations guarantee an exciting and varied day at the Murmliwasser.

On your way from the Komperdell mid station to the Murmliwasser, you'll be greeted by a five-metre-tall giant marmot that is just waiting for you to show off your climbing & sliding skills.

Covered adventure conveyor belt "Murmli & Friends". From the Murmliwasser to the Komperdell mid station.

Marmot Kiosk. Parents who'd rather not get wet can retreat to one of the cosy relaxation zones, or they can watch the fun and games from the patio of the Marmot Kiosk. (Kitchen open until 4.15pm)

Marmot Enclosure. Marmot Burrow. In the large outdoor marmot enclosure, you can watch our marmots as they feed, play or simply hang around; afterwards, you can experience life from a marmot perspective in the Marmot Burrow.

Marmot Rodeo. Four stations of fun and games with different levels of difficulty that demand agility and speed.

Kugelturm Tower & Giant Ball Run. Climbing frame, slide & giant ball run, all "rolled" into one! Wooden balls are available from the Marmot Kiosk.

GOLDEN MAN TRAIL. CHILDREN'S MINE, FISS.

Climbing giants, greedy gnomes and a "Golden Man" that was devoured by the mountains of Fiss are the main characters of a fairytale story that takes us way back to a time when the region was awash with legends. The hunt for the heart of the "Golden Man" begins when the young shepherd Fulgenz suddenly finds a piece of gold whilst exploring the mountains of Fiss and talks about his discovery down in the valley. Ever since, eerie laughter and gleeful cheers break the stillness of the night as the mean gnomes set off to mine the mountain with their hammers and pickaxes. Will Fulgenz and his friends be able to save the Golden Man from the greedy gnomes?

Success via eleven stations - the "Golden Man Trail"

Join Fulgenz and his friends on their mission to stop the greedy gnomes and defeat these mean dwarves with your knowledge of nature. On this adventure trail, you can look forward to eleven educational stations full of surprises. At the end, the Golden Man is bound to be grateful for your efforts.

Children's Mine. Once the Golden Man's breath had turned the gnomes to stone, the quarry became a truly amazing playground. On the Schönjoch in Fiss, mine explorers of all ages can look forward to many exciting play areas with balancing and coordination equipment, climbing frames, slides and swings, a maze and a cave adventure tunnel.

At the BergDiamant panorama restaurant, we'll spoil you with an international cuisine, dishes fresh from the wok and crisp salads, as well as an extensive cake buffet, delicious desserts and refreshing ice cream sundaes.

GEORAMA LASSIDA. SERFAUS.

The fascinating word of rocks and fossils: The Georama Lassida gives explorers and hobby scientists an insight into the world of geology and archaeology. In the huge sandy dig area at an altitude of 2,350 metres, children can go on a tour of exploration and discover rocks from primeval times.

Stone ball companions on their adventure: In the adventure area, stone balls made from a natural material are the children's constant companions. The stone marbles are available from a stone dispenser in the entrance area and are used at the stations with interactive games.

Motor skills trail: The motor skills trail calls for coordination, agility and balance.

Rest and relaxation in the Alpine garden: Whilst the kids zoom carefree around the motor skills trail, their parents can sit down and relax. The many rest and relaxation areas afford fantastic panoramic views.

Georama Loop Trail Lazid: This pram-friendly loop trail runs from Lazid to the top station of the Lawens cable car and back again. Hikers along the approx. 1.5km long loop trail are treated to the most glorious mountain views!

The best thing about it: The Lassida restaurant is located close by. It spoils its guests with a variety of delicacies ranging from hearty Tyrolean dishes to home-made wood oven pizza. Naturally, the menu also includes amazing home-made ice cream not to be missed!



PLAY^{IN} SERFAUS.

This huge indoor playground and climbing paradise directly at the Komperdell cable car bottom station in Serfaus offers everything that children need for entertainment: Play, fun and exercise.

The spacious indoor climbing centre offers twelve different climbing walls or lines such as the "Vulcano", the "Speed Competition Line", the "Spider Web", the "Geometrix Lines" (two free-standing towers) and many more. Free climbing shoe hire. The bouldering room next door looks a little like a huge chemistry laboratory.

Other highlights include an extensive six-tier soft play structure, a laser room that calls for coordination as well as speed, and an interactive digital activity wall.

INDOOR ARENA. FISS.

The Indoor Arena Fiss is located directly next to the Schönjoch cable car bottom station and is essentially divided into two areas.

One area consists of a very unusual 18-lane crazy golf course: The individual lanes feature special obstacles from the region, as well as numerous other surprises.

The crazy golf equipment can be hired at the ticket office for a charge.

The game area features various tabletop games such as tabletop football, air hockey, pool, Catch the Light and all sorts of other tabletop games to keep older children entertained.

There is also a dedicated play area for very young children with a wendy house, a slide and various wall and tabletop games.

The Indoor Arena Fiss is open daily from 8.30am to 5pm and is the perfect place to have fun in any weather.

BEHIND THE SCENES. SERFAUS. FISS. LADIS.

What goes on behind the scenes at the cable car stations, and how do cable cars actually work?

The Serfaus-Fiss-Ladis region lifts the lid on these and many other mysteries. A guided tour through the trail maintenance equipment workshop provides an insight into the effort involved, and shows how skilled the cable car staff are.

Whilst the guided tour in Serfaus always includes the underground, the Fiss tour focuses on the technology behind the Schönjoch cable car. After a closer look at our all-weather snowmaking machines, the tour finishes with coffee and cake, which provides a final opportunity to ask further questions.

LADIS VIA FERRATA. LADIS.

Put your climbing skills to the test in Ladis! Laudeck Castle is perched spectacularly on top of a crystalline slate rock formation that offers the perfect conditions for an eventful day spent rock climbing. The "Quarzit Wand Burg Laudeck" via ferratas offer all climbing fans three short but exciting routes with the wonderful sounding names "Via Claudia Augusta" (blue), "Pons Laudes Steig" (red) and "Laudecksteig" (black).

Via Claudia Augusta. Various climbing elements such as wooden footholds, a climbing net and a shaky bridge high up on the air that runs directly along the rock face add interest to this via ferrata. The undisputed highlight is a wooden bridge that takes some courage to cross.

Pons Laudes Via Ferrata. This medium difficulty via ferrata is on the left of the first route and is therefore a little more difficult to manage, as the two steep difficulty level C stretches call for quite a bit of muscle power. There are also relatively few footholds.

Laudecksteig Via Ferrata. Good climbing skills and muscle power are needed for the difficult Laudecksteig via ferrata as it starts with a slight overhang. It takes a lot of physical strength and good coordination to get past this initial point.

WOLFSEE. FISS.

Realm of lynxes, wolves and bears.

A walking and recreational trail for the whole family has been created all around the Wolfsee, a reservoir close to Fiss. The circular walk blends into the gentle, hilly landscape and is well worth a visit even just for the views: Deciduous and larch forests broken by meadows and masses of flowers. The banks of the reservoir also offer an exceptional educational experience for adventurous and curious kids where they can learn more about the behaviour and habitats of the wild lynxes, wolves and bears through play. Besides a set of adventure steps for climbing and balancing, there is also a bear's den for them to explore, a small stream to splash about in and much more. In the section dedicated to the lynx, children and their parents sneak along the edge of the forest like hunting predators until they reach a play and information area in the shape of a lynx paw print. A cave not only affords spectacular views of the Wolfsee through a waterfall but also features several information boards with lots of fun facts about brown bears. The adventure steps, made up of various climbing and balancing elements, also lead directly to the bear's den, and because bears love honey, as every child knows, there is also a beehive-shaped climbing tower and a carousel with a honey pot.

Geochaching

The starting point is the tourist information office in Fiss, where everything you need to know about the cache is displayed on an information board. The exciting GPS treasure hunt pays homage to the wild animals that used to live here on the high plateau, such as wolves, bears and lynxes.
